## OTHER ITEMS OF NOTE

- ✓ **Campers 16 years of age or older at the time of the camp will need a fishing license. Visit: <https://mdc-web.s3licensing.com/> to register online.**
- ✓ Please consider the weather and the various outdoor activities you will be doing throughout the week of camp as you pack.
- ✓ Make sure that shirts are appropriate for a faith-based environment. Shirts with sexual innuendo, sarcasm or demeaning sayings are not permitted. Shirts with cut off sleeves, tank tops, muscle shirts are fine for activities, but will not be worn for chapel events. Shorts and pants should be without rips, holes or patches.
- ✓ All prescriptions and over-the-counter meds will be given to the Camp Director upon arrival. These will be dispensed as directed. Epipens will go where we go at all times. The camp does provide standard, over-the-counter medications and first aid should the need arise.
- ✓ Any electronic devices will be collected and securely stored for the duration of camp. This is not just to encourage campers to enter fully into the camping experience, but to also guard against the possibility of inappropriate photo or social media usage during camp. The Camp Director will be accessible to parents 24/7 should a parent need to communicate with their child during camp.
